# Analysis of Student Incident Data and Arrests

- Used incident reports from Student Incident Reporting System (SIRS) to further investigate security violations by race.
- Grouped data into five major categories for analysis of arrests: Communicating Threats, Fighting, Possession of Controlled Substances, Possession of a Weapon, and Theft.
- Disparities exist for fighting and theft arrests



# Disparities by Race: Fighting

- The odds of being arrested for fighting are 1.67 times higher for Black students as compared to other students ( $p < 0.01$ ).

## Disparities by Race: Theft

- The odds of being arrested for theft are 1.7 times higher for Black students as compared to other students ( $p < 0.05$ ).
